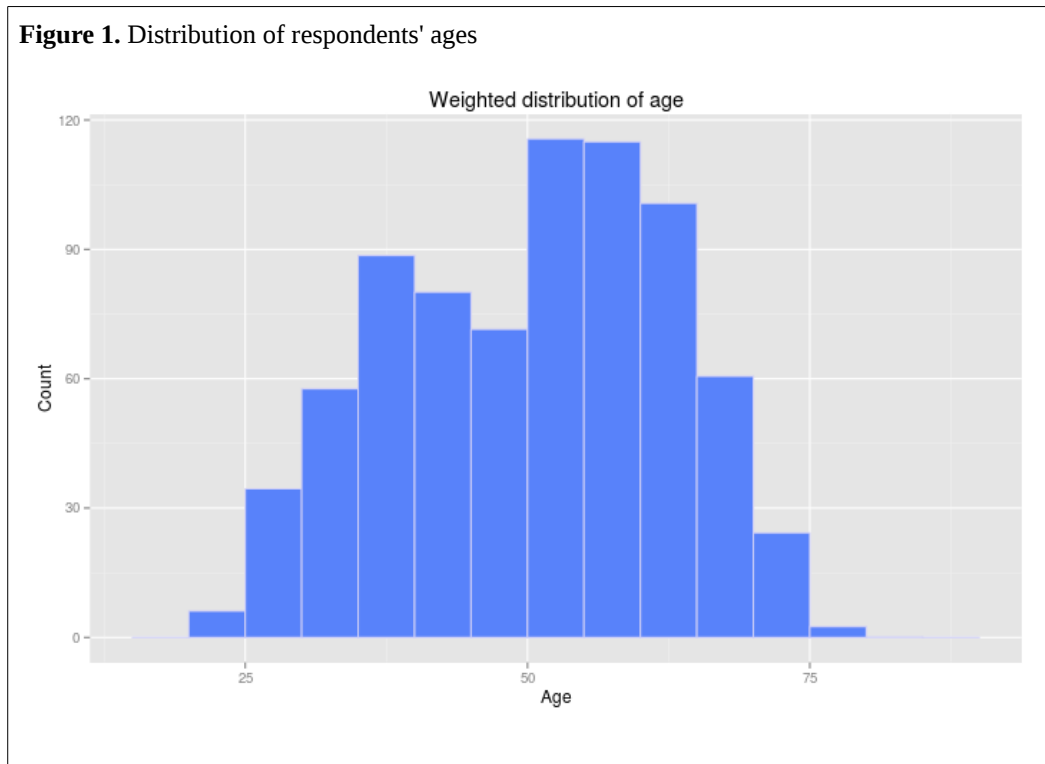

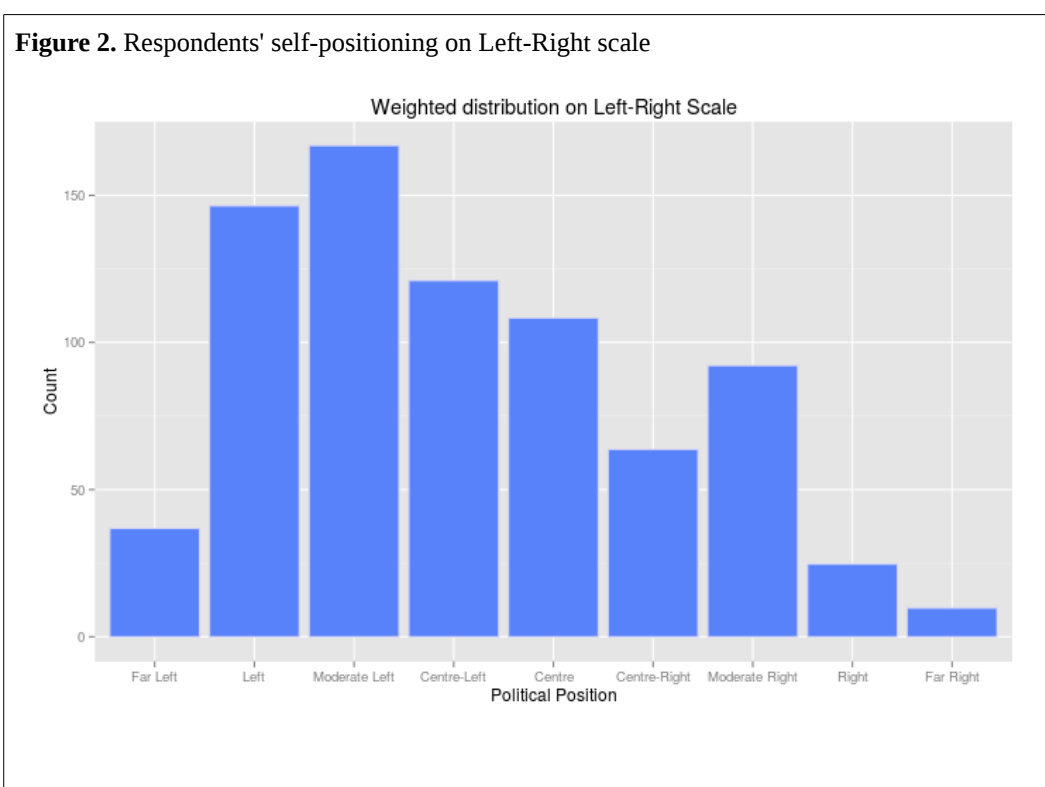

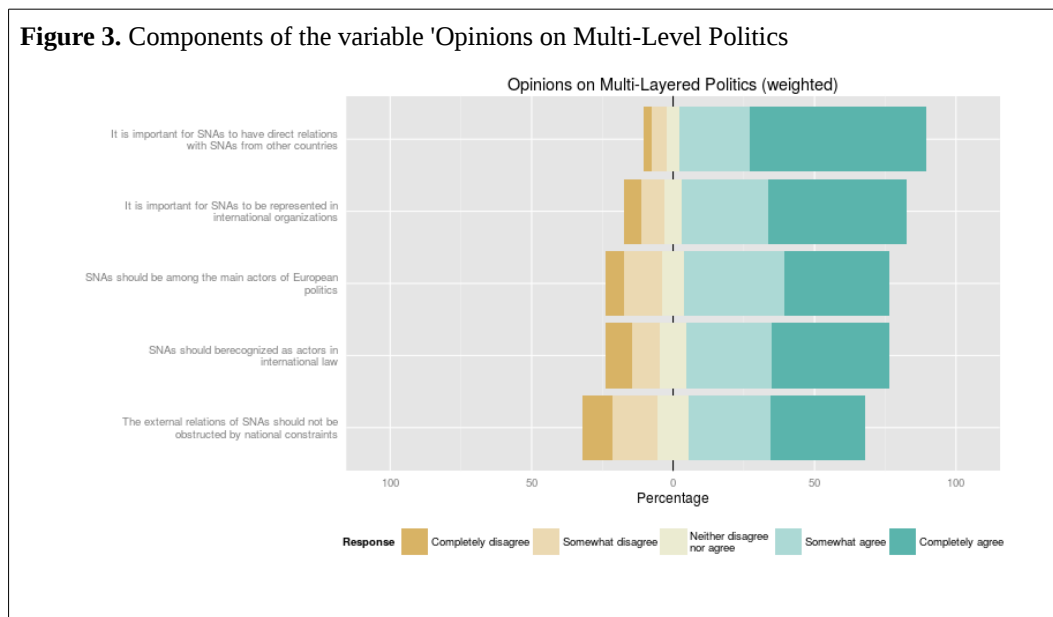

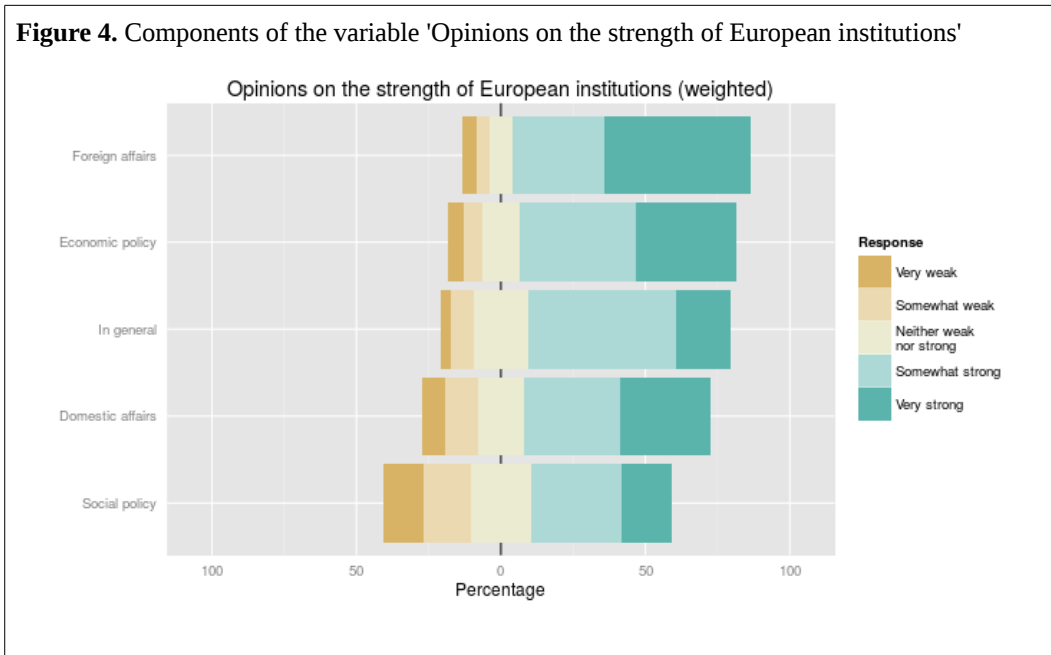

**Figure 3.** Components of the variable 'Opinions on Multi-Level Politics



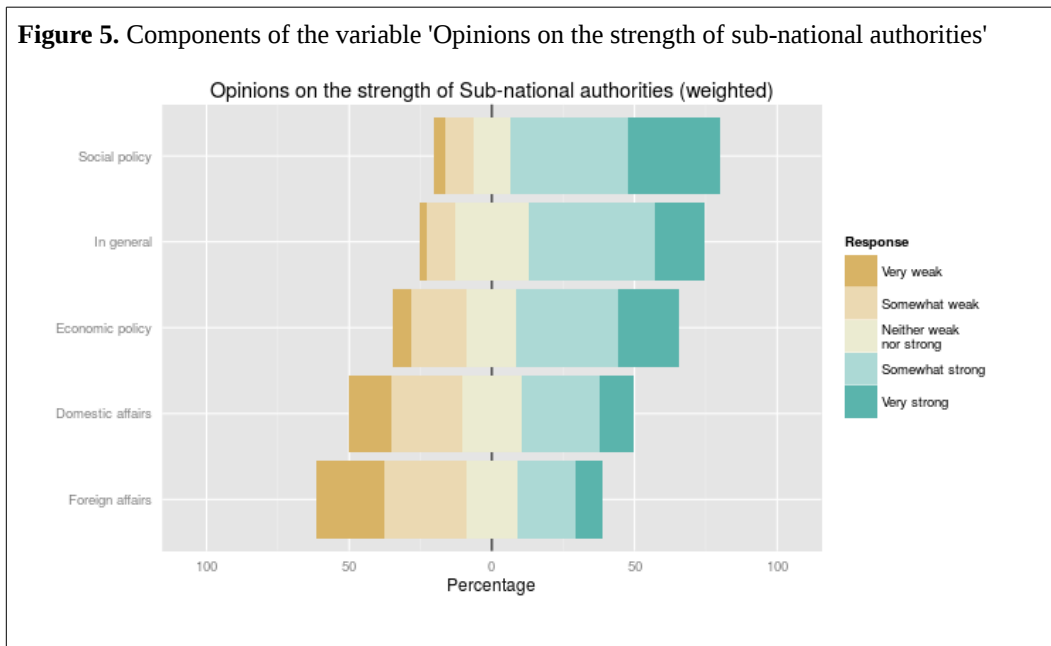

**Figure 4.** Components of the variable 'Opinions on the strength of European institutions'



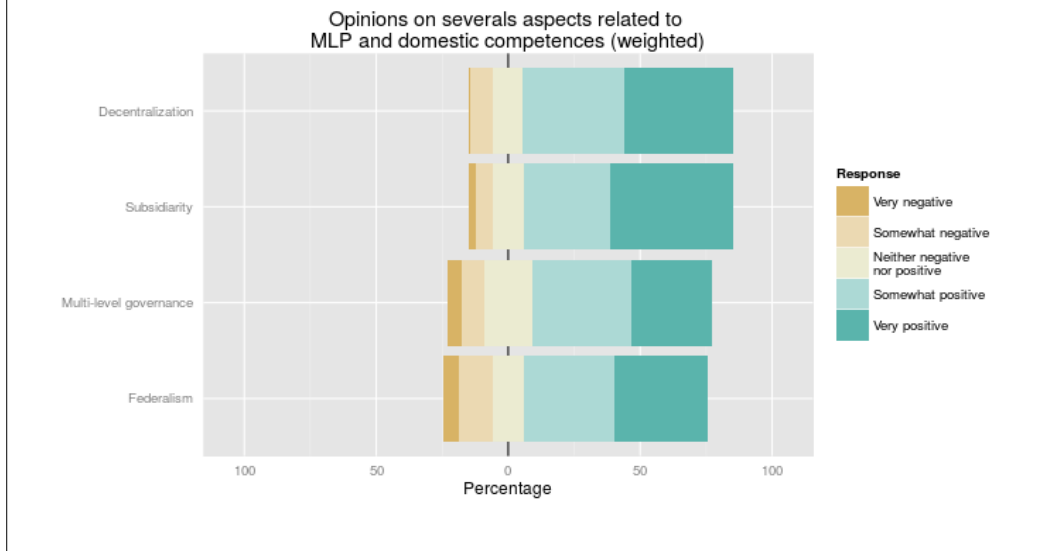

**Figure 6.** Possible additional dimensions of opinions on multi-level politics and sub-national competences

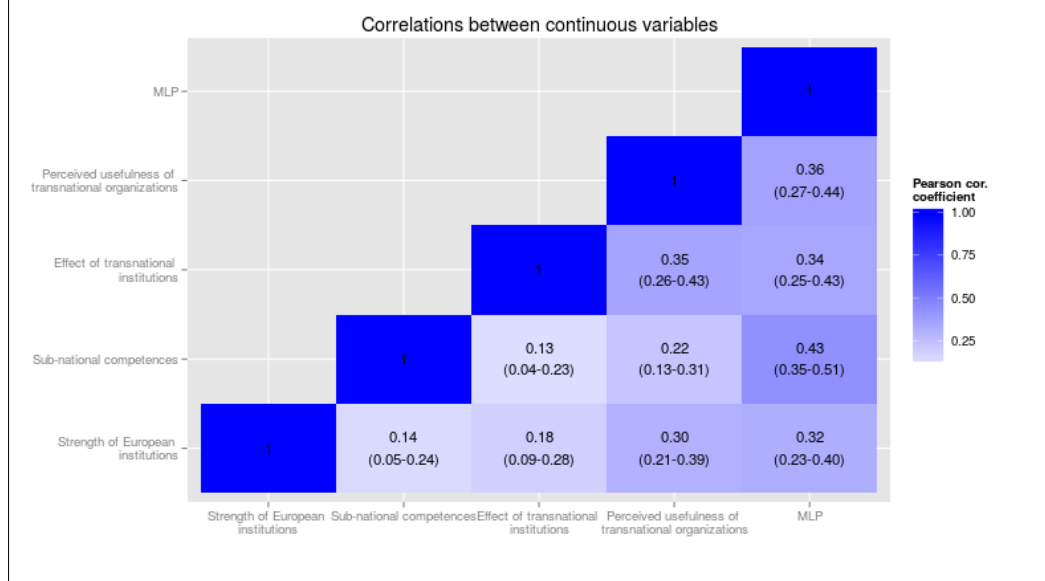

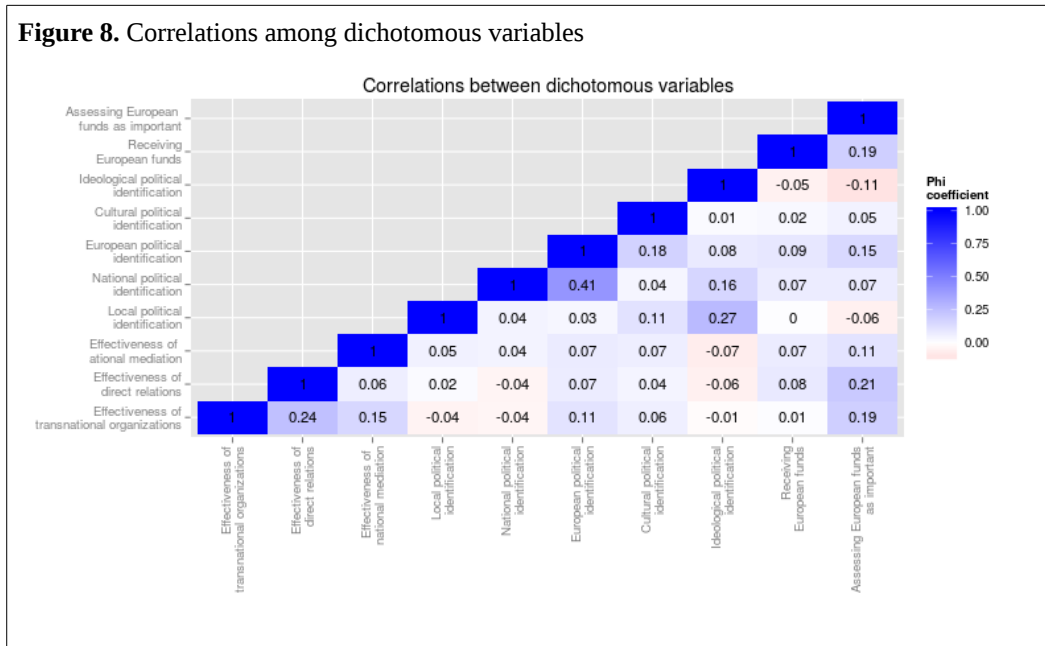
